FOCUS

1. Our choices and decisions affect ourselves and others.
2. Jesus shows us how to live.

During lesson time your child:

- *named some of the people in their neighbourhood;*
- *illustrated ways they could help people outside their family;*
- *recalled what Jesus taught about loving others.*

Luke 10: 25-28
