

Growing in friendship with God

FOCUS

1. God is present and active in creation. We are challenged to find God's presence in the world around us.
2. All creation is indeed good and we are to be responsible for the care of it. This is a role given to us by God, and one which we must take seriously.
3. We are created in the image of God.
4. All human life is sacred. Human life is to be respected and is always a marvelous gift of God's goodness. (Pope John Paul II in *Familiaris Consortio*).
5. Prayer to a loving God is natural. It is a human response that unites us with the divine. God created us so that we could have a loving friendship with him.

During these lessons your child may have:

- *recognised God as creator of all things and the goodness of God's creation;*
- *developed an awareness that we have a duty to care for and develop the gifts of creation;*
- *suggested ways that they can care for gifts of creation in their own lives;*
- *recognised that each person is unique and special because each is made in God's image and likeness;*
- *listened and responded to a story of Jesus at prayer;*
- *identified that prayer strengthens our relationship with God.*

Genesis 1:1-31

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Now the earth was a formless void, there was darkness over the deep, and God's spirit hovered over the water. God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. . . . God created man in the image of himself, in the image of God he created him, male and female he created them . . . let them be masters of the fish of the sea, the birds of the heaven, the cattle, all the wild beasts and all the reptiles that crawl upon the earth . . . Mark 1:35-38


