SRE classes postponed until further notice

As you will have heard, on 14 June the Premier announced ongoing restrictions in response to COVID-19, with the lockdown in Greater Sydney and restrictions in the regions continuing until 30 July 2021.

The Department of Education is working closely with NSW Health and continues to keep us well informed with weekly online meetings.

The Department will advise us when SRE is permitted again. The timeframe for this will be subject to NSW Health recommendations.

Currently, Greater Sydney students are learning from home, but schools are open for students and their families who need it.

The Department will advise schools of the availability of the three "SRE Learning from Home" portals (Christian SRE, Better Balanced Futures and Primary Ethics) to allow them to inform their school community.

Our Catholic SRE Learning from Home materials appear on the Christian SRE portal.

We will keep you informed of any updates from the Department and will supply advice about contacting schools following further consultation with the Department.

The Christmas Story Art Competition

In the hope that SRE classes will commence in August...



Catechists teaching Years 5 & 6 SRE are encouraged to explore Christmas Gospel passages from St Luke or St Matthew with their students. These are found in Lessons 30-32 of the curriculum. This is an opportunity to reflect on the true meaning of Christmas without all the commercialism.

Any of these texts can be used:

YEAR 5 'Journey to Bethlehem' (Luke 2: 1-5) 'Prepare the Way' (Isaiah 40: 3-5) 'The Birth of Jesus and the Visit of the Shepherds' (Luke 2: 9-14) 'The Birth of Jesus and Visit of the Magi' (Matthew 1: 18-25, Matthew 2: 9-12)

YEAR 6 'Journey to Bethlehem' (Luke 2: 1-5) 'The Annunciation' (Luke 1: 26-36) 'The Flight to Egypt' (Matthew 2: 13-15) 'The Birth of Jesus and Visit of the Magi' (Matthew 1: 18-25, Matthew 2: 9-12)

We need to help the students see how the Christmas Story is relevant and personal to their lives. We need to help them encounter Christ in some way or at least recognise that Christ has something he wants to say to us through this text.

Students write a short reflection on the chosen passage. They are then encouraged to use art as a medium to express this reflection. This helps the students see how the Christmas Story is relevant and personal to their lives.

You could use a Think Chart over four lessons to help your students produce a reflection and artwork. <u>https://docs.google.com/document/d/1fJi-z9CJ0xp_x5BUrO2xzQ-tVQRZyjl4VXpiYblvHX0/edit</u>

The artwork is prepared on A3 cartridge paper 110gsm in landscape or portrait mode. There is no need to frame or laminate these artworks.

Artworks will be judged based on their artistic merit and on the artist's original personal self-reflection of the chosen Scripture.

Each artwork must have the student's reflection of the Scripture passage attached to the back of the artwork with the following information:

- Artwork Title
- · Student's full name and age
- · School's full name and suburb
- Student's year


The artworks should be sent or hand-delivered by Friday 17 September to:
