From the Director

Update | Special Religious Education (SRE)

Dear Catechists and Coordinators,

I hope and pray this message finds you well as we pray for our school communities and one another. The Department of Education is continuing to work towards schools welcoming students back to face-to-face learning from mid-Term 4 under Level 3 CovidSafe measures that limit student mingling.

SRE will only begin after the Department allows schools to move to Level 2 restrictions.

If yes: if the Department advises SRE can resume before Christmas, CCD will supply you with an updated "Return to SRE Guide".

If no: if the Department advises SRE cannot resume this year, CCD will provide a suggested letter template for parishes to email to schools to advise parents about SRE, e.g. to alert parents when children will bring home SRE Student Activity Books along with providing a way for families to access online Advent/Christmastide resources and any parish invitations to online/face-to-face Christmas celebrations.

Either way: whether SRE returns before Christmas or not, CCD will advise Clergy and Catechist Coordinators about the **importance of holding Term 4 meetings with schools** (as per <u>NSW SRE Procedures 3.4)</u> to discuss end-of-year SRE requests to support students and advise parents; and, to plan for 2022 SRE classes (best avoid asking anything of schools during the planned return-to-school weeks of late Oct-mid Nov).

Christmas cards: we appreciate that many Catechists lovingly hand out Christmas cards or, particularly for Year 6, little Catholic Life-Prayer items – with their parish and school's permission. Whilst there is no expectation to do this, if this has been your practice, I'm sure many schools would welcome such acts of kindness, given shared concern for student wellbeing. Again, asking if Christmas cards may be given out is best discussed by Clergy/Catechist Coordinators with school leaders during a Term 4 online/phone meeting (schools infection-control rules can help with this).

Recruitment: this is essential and CCD will provide a pack. I have asked in the Clergy Newsletter for these <u>recruitment videos</u> to be played before or after online Masses – I trust you will give "continual and unwavering encouragement" until your parish kindly does so. It is also worth noting, if any Catechists have **health concerns**, there is no rush for you to make decisions about your continued SRE service, given we do not yet know if SRE will return this year.

We will keep you posted and, right now, I wish to simply ask for us all to continue to pray that all families at home are inspired to go gently and lovingly.

God bless you and Saint Joseph, pray for us.


Annual Archdiocesan Catechist Mass 2021


