SRE classes are expected to commence in Term 1 by Week 4 (end of February).

Public schools currently require all adults accessing school sites to be vaccinated. Catechists who are unable to return can help in other ways. CCD will advise Clergy and Catechist Coordinators of any updates and supply a 2022 Return to SRE Guide.

Maureen and Lila have decided this will be their final year teaching Catholic SRE. Thank you both, for your beautiful witness of love, generosity and joy.


